

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Bayanan, Bacoor City, Cavite

as of 12 April 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 03 April 2023 at around 10PM, a fire incident occurred at Progressive 6, Brgy. Bayanan, Bacoor City, Cavite. The fire was declared out at around 10:37 PM.

There are **27 families** or **127 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at **Console Village Covered Court** in **Bacoor City** (see Table 2).
