1. Standby Funds

- ₱41.04 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5.49 million available at DSWD FO CALABARZON.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 36,289 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 15,761 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 20,528 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 44,500 FFPs available at DSWD FO CALABARZON.
- ₱291.04 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO CALABARZON warehouses.

c. Other Activities

04 April 2023	 DSWD FO CALABARZON closely coordinated with the City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO) of the LGU of Bacoor City for significant updates and any request of relief augmentation. The Emergency Operations Center (EOC) of DSWD FO CALABARZON in the LGU of Bacoor City were placed on alert status to monitor the incident.

The Disaster Response Operations Monitoring and Information Center (DROMIC) of DSWD-DRMB is closely coordinating with DSWD FO CALABARZON for significant disaster response updates and assistance provided.
