I. Situation Overview

On 09 April 2023 at around 12:30 AM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Batobato, Brgy. Dolores, Taytay, Rizal. The fire was declared out at around 3:20 AM.

- 70,140 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 35,293 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 34,847 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 44,888 FFPs available at DSWD FO CALABARZON.
- ₱294.94 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO CALABARZON warehouses.


