

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Doña Imelda, Quezon City

as of 08 April 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 07 April 2023 at 10:12 PM, a fire incident occurred at 100 Kapiligan St., Brgy. Doña Imelda, Quezon City. It was declared fire out at around 11:55 PM. The cause of fire is still under investigation

- 70,140 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 35,293 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 34,847 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 28,844 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
- ₱273.4 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.
