I. Situation Overview

On 05 April 2023 at around 5:42 PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Bato, Brgy. Ermita, Cebu City. The fire was declared out around 6:38 PM.

- 70,140 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 35,293 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 34,847 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 45,615 FFPs available at DSWD FO VII.
- ₱295.65 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VII warehouses.
