I. Situation Overview

On 31 March 2023 at around 8:28 PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Gaboc, Brgy. Malaiba, Canlaon City, Negros Oriental. The fire was declared out at around 8:58 PM.

1. Standby Funds

- ₱41.04 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO VII.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 36,289 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 15,761 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 20,528 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 47,223 FFPs available at DSWD FO VII.
- ₱291.48 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VII warehouses.
