

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Mambaling, Cebu City

as of 23 April 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 19 April 2023, at around 2:46PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Manga, Brgy. Mambaling, Cebu City. The fire was under control at around 2:43PM and was declared out at around 3:05PM.
