- 43,105 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 11,977 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 31,128 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 63,275 FFPs available at DSWD FO XI.
- ₱211.21 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO XI warehouses.
