I. Situation Overview

On 30 March 2023 at around 10:12 AM, a fire incident occurred at Caliwag St., Brgy. Pinagbuhatan, Pasig City. The fire was declared out at around 11:57 AM.

1. Standby Funds

- ₱46.89 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO NCR.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 69,540 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 22,893 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 46,647 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 4,287 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
- ₱261.61 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.
