### I. Situation Overview

On 08 April 2023 at around 12:31 PM, a fire incident occurred at Zone 2, Brgy. Poblacion, Tagoloan, Misamis Oriental. The fire was declared out at around 2:32 PM.

- ₱325.73 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO X warehouses.

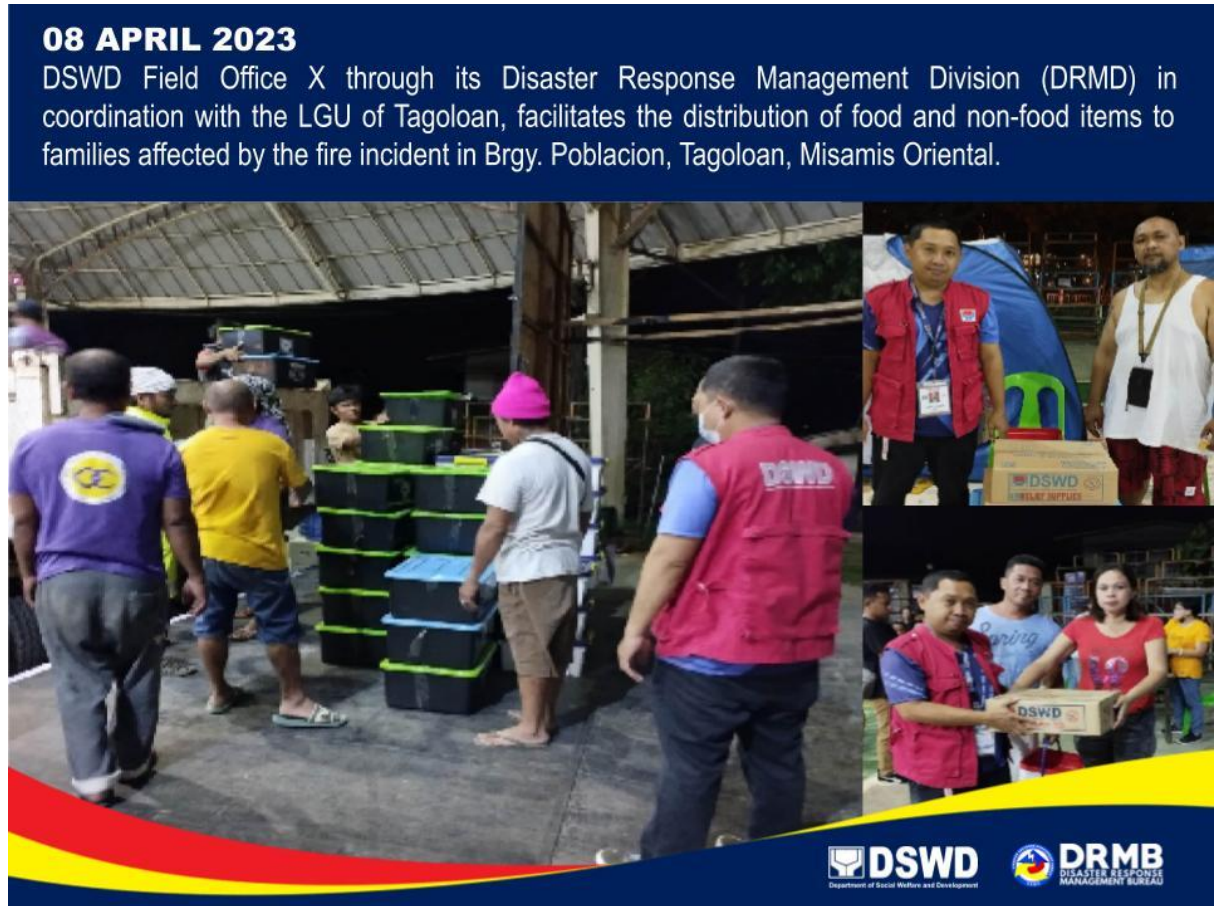
