2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 70,140 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 35,293 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 34,847 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 87,117 FFPs available at DSWD FO VI.
- ₱275.91 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VI warehouses.
