

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Tuburan, Pagadian City, Zamboanga del Sur

as of 28 April 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 25 April 2023 at around 12AM, a fire incident occurred at Purok Lower Lumboy, Brgy. Tuburan, Pagadian City, Zamboanga del Sur. The fire was declared out at around 1:37AM.
