



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flashflood Incident in Region XII as of 05 April 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 31 March 2023, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms caused by easterlies or localized thunderstorms may have caused flashfloods or landslides during severe thunderstorms in Metro Manila and the rest of the country.

From 31 March to 02 April 2023, low-lying municipalities in the Provinces of Cotabato and Sultan Kudarat experienced flashfloods caused by either easterlies or localized thunderstorms.

1. Standby Funds

- ₱46.81 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO XII.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 74,840 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 39,993 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 34,847 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 24,342 FFPs available at DSWD FO XII.
- ₱288.63 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO XII warehouses.

b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)

04 April 2023	DSWD FO XII released 836 FFPs to Bagumbayan, Sultan Kudarat intended for the affected families. In addition, five (5) families with totally damaged houses were also provided with kitchen kits, family kits, and sleeping kits.






DATE	ACTIVITIES
03 April 2023	The LGU of Bagumbayan, Sultan Kudarat distributed food packs to the affected families.

c. Other Activities

03 April 2023	 DSWD FO XII coordinated with the affected LGUs for significant updates and any request of relief augmentation. DSWD FO XII through its Disaster Response Management Division (DRMD) conducted field validation of the affected barangays in Kabacan, Cotabato and Bagumbayan, Sultan Kudarat.
02 April 2023	 The Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (MDRRMO) of Kabacan, Cotabato conducted ocular inspection and assessment of the affected barangays.
