



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flooding Incident in Pantukan, Davao de Oro

as of 26 April 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 24 April 2023, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rain showers or thunderstorms due to Easterlies / Localized Thunderstorms may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms over metro Manila and the rest of the country.

On the same day at around 3PM, flooding was experienced in Brgy. Kingking, Pantukan, Davao de Oro due to continuous heavy rains reported in the area.
