



# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Shooting Incident in Brgy. Gokutan, Pikit, North Cotabato

as of 27 April 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 23 April 2023 at around 5AM, an exchange of fire between the Philippine National Police (PNP) and a person on wanted list transpired at Brgy. Gokutan, Pikit, North Cotabato which resulted in the displacement of families or persons residing in the said barangay.

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 118 families or 590 persons currently taking temporary shelter in a designated evacuation center in Brgy. Malapang, Aleosan, Cotabato Province (see Table 2).

- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO XII.

## 2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 34,934 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 11,706 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 23,228 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 20,781 FFPs available at DSWD FO XII.
- ₱195.22 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO XII warehouses.
