### I. Situation Overview

On 13 April 2023, a social disorganization incident transpired at Palijog, Brgy. Mabilong, Lubuagan, Kalinga that also economically affected the livelihood of nearby barangays.

- 27,854 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 1,226 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 26,628 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
