1. Standby Funds

- ₱46.81 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱3.58 million available at DSWD FO II.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 74,840 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 39,993 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 34,847 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 56,030 FFPs available at DSWD FO II.
- ₱281.97 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO II warehouses.

25 March 2023	 The Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO) of Mallig, Isabela conducted assessment for the provision of assistance to the bereaved family of the victims.
