



# DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Rogongon, Iligan City, Lanao del Norte

as of 11 April 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 06 April 2023 at around 8AM, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Cangahan 1A and 1B in Brgy. Rogongon, Iligan City between the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and the New People's Army (NPA).

A total of 135 families or 570 persons are affected in Brgy. Rogongon, Iligan City (see Table 1).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of 135 families or 570 persons sought temporary shelter at Digkilaan Gym in Brgy. Rogongon, Iligan City (see Table 2). These families have returned to their respective homes upon clearance from the AFP.

A total of \$\mathbb{P}279,366.40\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}160,466.40\$ was provided by \$\mathbb{DSWD}\$ and \$\mathbb{P}118,900.00\$ from the \$\mathbb{Local}\$ Government Unit (LGU) (see Table 3).
