

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. San Rafael, Rodriguez, Rizal

as of 11 April 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 31 March 2023 at around 8:30 AM, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Wawa, Brgy. San Rafael, Rodriguez, Rizal between the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and members of the Communist Terrorist Group – New People’s Army (CTG-NPA).
