



DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Armed Conflict in Datu Saudi Ampatuan, Maguindanao

as of 19 April 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 04 April 2023 at around 2PM, an armed conflict transpired between the alleged members of two (2) Moro Islamic Liberation Front (MILF) groups at the market square of Brgy. Elian, Datu Saudi Ampatuan, Maguindanao.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **1,912 families** or **9,560 persons** are affected in **four (4) barangays** in **Datu Saudi Ampatuan, Maguindanao** (see Table 1).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There were **1,474 families** or **7,370 persons** who sought temporary shelter in **nine (9) evacuation centers** in **Datu Saudi Ampatuan, Maguindanao** (see Table 2).
