I. Situation Overview

On 09 April 2023 at around 12:30 AM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Batobato, Brgy. Dolores, Taytay, Rizal. The fire was declared out at around 3:20 AM.

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **152 families** or **637 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Golden City Covered Court** in **Brgy. Dolores, Taytay, Rizal** (see Table 2).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱28.48million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5.5 million available at DSWD FO CALABARZON.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 50,484 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 20,956 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 29,528 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 41,347 FFPs available at DSWD FO CALABARZON.
- ₱252.52 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO CALABARZON warehouses.





b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)

12 April 2023	 DSWD FO CALABARZON distributed FNIs such as sleeping kits and 6.6L drinking water, and hygiene kits donated by AHA Center and Unilever Foundation to the affected families.
09 April 2023	• The LGU of Taytay, Rizal immediately provided the affected families with basic needs such as hot meals, sleeping kits, and hygiene kits.

c. Camp Coordination and Camp Management (CCCM)

09 April 2023	 DSWD FO CALABARZON provided technical assistance to the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO) of the LGU of Taytay, Rizal relative to the management of information and evacuation center.

d. Other Activities

12 April 2023	DSWD FO CALABARZON made a courtesy call with Mayor Allan Martine S. De Leon of Taytay, Rizal together with their MSWDO staff to check on the current situation of the affected families and the plan of the LGU for possible provision of response and early recovery services.
10 April 2023	 DSWD FO CALABARZON coordinated with the MSWDO of the LGU of Taytay, Rizal and the Rizal Provincial Social Welfare and Development Office (PSWDO) as well as with other concerned offices for significant updates and any request of relief augmentation. DSWD FO CALABARZON conducted assessment on the current situation of the displaced families in evacuation center to identify appropriate technical assistance to the LGU of Taytay, Rizal.

The Disaster Response Operations Monitoring and Information Center (DROMIC) of DSWD-DRMB is closely coordinating with DSWD FO CALABARZON for significant disaster response updates and assistance provided.
