I. Situation Overview

On 21 April 2023 at around 10AM, a fire incident occurred at Dumalag 1, Brgy. Matina Aplaya, Davao City. The fire was declared out at around 12PM.

- 43,105 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 11,977 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 31,128 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 62,064 FFPs available at DSWD FO XI.
- ₱214.66 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO XI warehouses.
