



# DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Pinagbuhatan, Pasig City

as of 05 April 2023, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 30 March 2023 at around 10:12 AM, a fire incident occurred at Caliwag St., Brgy. Pinagbuhatan, Pasig City. The fire was declared out at around 11:57 AM.

A total of **202 families** or **695 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Pinagbuhatan, Pasig City** (see Table 1).
