

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Rizal Pala-Pala II, Iloilo City

I. Situation Overview

On 29 April 2023 at around 8:50 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Rizal Pala-Pala II, Iloilo City. It was declared fire out at around 10:36 AM.

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **110 families** or **394 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Rizal Elementary School** in **Brgy. Rizal Pala-Pala II, Iloilo City** (see Table 2).
