I. Situation Overview

On 29 April 2023 at around 8:50 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Rizal Pala-Pala II, Iloilo City. It was declared fire out at around 10:36 AM.

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 110 families or 394 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Rizal Elementary School in Brgy. Rizal Pala-Pala II, Iloilo City (see Table 2).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱28.48million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO VI.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 35,788 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 12,560 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 23,228 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 79,779 FFPs available at DSWD FO VI.
- ₱202.43 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VI warehouses.





b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)

30 April 2023	 DSWD FO VI through its DRMD-DRRS closely coordinated with the City Social Welfare Development Office (CSWDO) for the immediate augmentation of Food and Non-Food Items to the affected and displaced families or persons.
