

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Sinawilan, Digos City, Davao del Sur as of 04 May 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 28 April 2023 at around 10:20AM, a fire incident occurred in Purok San Vicente, Brgy. Sinawilan, Digos City, Davao del Sur. The fire was declared out 12:30 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **38 families** or **96 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Sinawilan, Digos City** (see Table 1).

- ₱222.59 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO XI warehouses.

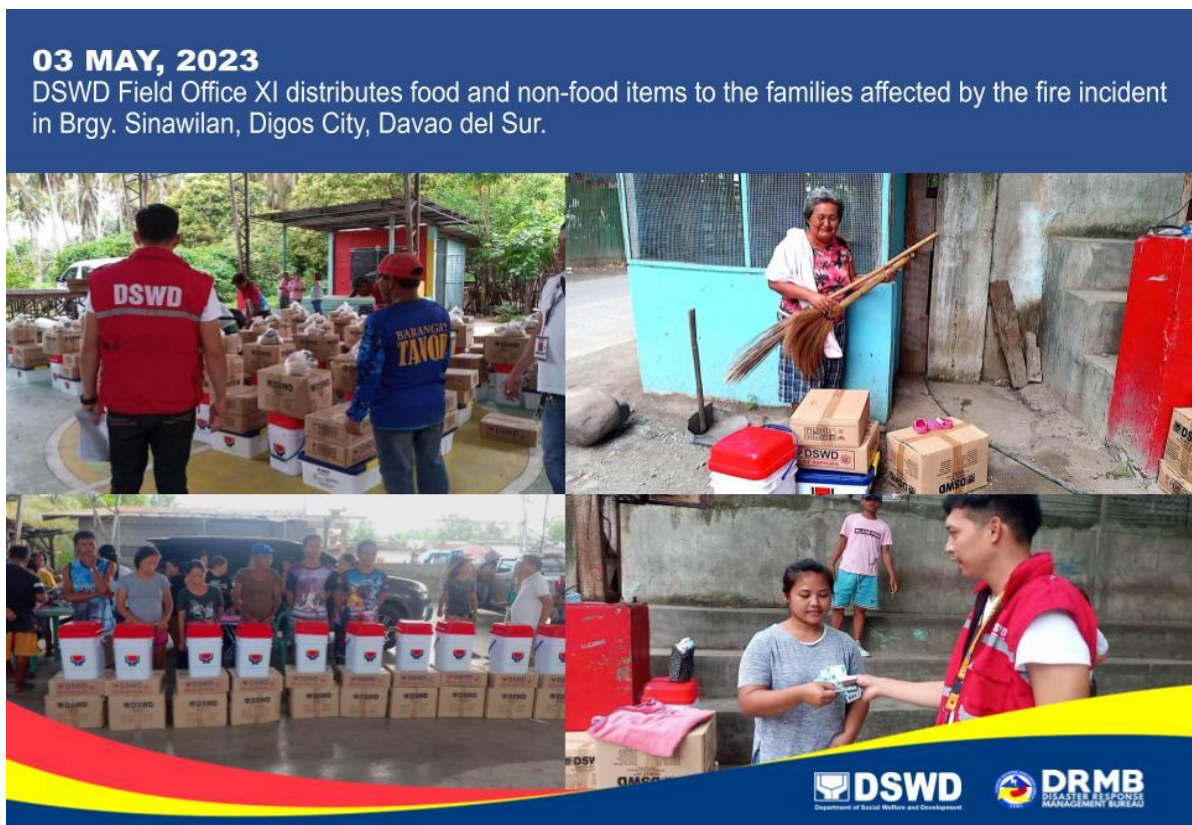
