

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Strong Wind Incident in Lambunao, Iloilo

as of 27 April 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 21 April 2023 at around 2PM, a strong wind incident occurred in the Municipality of Lambunao, Iloilo due to localized thunderstorms causing damaged to houses.

A total of **14 families** or **54 persons** are affected in **three (3) barangays** in **Lambunao, Iloilo** (see Table 1).
