



DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Rogongon, Iligan City, Lanao del Norte

as of 18 April 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 06 April 2023 at around 8AM, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Cangahan 1A and 1B in Brgy. Rogongon, Iligan City between the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and the New People's Army (NPA).

A total of **574 families** or **2,428 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Rogongon, Iligan City** (see Table 1).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **574 families** or **2,428 persons** sought temporary shelter at **Digkilaan Gym** in **Brgy. Rogongon, Iligan City** (see Table 2). These families have returned to their respective homes upon clearance from the AFP.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 54,705 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 23,177 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 31,528 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 31,443 FFPs available at DSWD FO X.
