I. Situation Overview

On 09 April 2023 at around 12:30 AM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Batobato, Brgy. Dolores, Taytay, Rizal. The fire was declared out at around 3:20 AM.

10 April 2023	<ul style="list-style-type: none">DSWD FO CALABARZON coordinated with the MSWDO of the LGU of Taytay, Rizal and the Rizal Provincial Social Welfare and Development Office (PSWDO) as well as with other concerned offices for significant updates and any request of relief augmentation.DSWD FO CALABARZON conducted assessment on the current situation of the displaced families in evacuation center to identify appropriate technical assistance to the LGU of Taytay, Rizal.

The Disaster Response Operations Monitoring and Information Center (DROMIC) of DSWD-DRMB is closely coordinating with DSWD FO CALABARZON for significant disaster response updates and assistance provided.
