I. Situation Overview

On 08 April 2023 at around 12:31 PM, a fire incident occurred at Zone 2, Brgy. Poblacion, Tagoloan, Misamis Oriental. The fire was declared out at around 2:32 PM. Source: DSWD Field Office (FO) X

A total of **27 families** or **99 persons** are affected at **Zone 2, Brgy. Poblacion, Tagoloan, Misamis Oriental** (see Table 1).

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **10 families** or **39 persons** who sought temporary shelter at the **Tagoloan Dome** in **Brgy. Poblacion, Tagoloan, Misamis Oriental** (see Table 2).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱28.48 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO X.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 27,854 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 1,226 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 26,628 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 37,641 FFPs available at DSWD FO X.

b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)

11 April 2023	 DSWD FO X provided FNIs such as FFPs, family kits, hygiene kits, kitchen kits, sleeping kits, and Ready-to-Eat Foods to the affected families. The Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO) of Tagoloan also provided food and non-food items to the affected families.

c. Other Activities

DATE	ACTIVITIES
25 April 2023	 DSWD FO X continuously coordinates with the MSWDO of Tagoloan and other concerned offices for significant disaster updates and for further request of relief augmentation. DSWD FO X provided financial assistance to the affected families through Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situations (AICS) amounting to a total of ₱210,000.00.

The Disaster Response Operations Monitoring and Information Center (DROMIC) of DSWD-DRMB is closely coordinating with DSWD FO X for significant disaster response updates and assistance provided.
