

DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Sapangdaku, Cebu City as of 21 June 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 14 March 2023 at around 2:45 PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Lupa, Brgy. Sapangdaku, Cebu City. The fire was declared out at around 3:30 PM.

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **67 families** or **248 persons** sought temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. Sapangdaku, Cebu City** (see Table 2).
