I. Situation Overview

On 10 April 2023, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Bacbacon, Brgy. Cabadiangan, Kadingilan, Bukidnon between the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and unidentified armed groups.

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **143 families** or **667 persons** sought temporary shelter in **four (4) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. Cabadiangan, Kadingilan, Bukidnon** (see Table 2).
