

## DSWD DROMIC Report on the Aviation Incident in Brgy. Ditarum, Divilacan, Isabela

19 April 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 24 January 2023, the Cessna 206 plane with tail number RPC1174 bound to Maconacon, Isabela was reported missing. The plane left Cauayan Airport at 2:15 PM and was last contacted by the air traffic controller at 2:19 PM on the same day while at the vicinity of Naguilian Bridge in Isabela.

On 09 March 2023, the Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines (CAAP) confirmed that the wreckage of the Cessna 206 plane was found along Sierra Madre in the area of responsibility of Brgy. Ditarum, Divilacan, Isabela by several Dumagat tribe members and teams from the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP).

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

**Six (6) persons**, which includes the pilot and the five passengers, were retrieved in the wreckage of the Cessna 206 plane (see Table 1).

### III. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱383,321.50** worth of assistance was provided to the bereaved families; of which, **₱7,210.00** was from **DSWD** and **₱376,111.50** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Table 2).
