

## DSWD DROMIC Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Banago, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental

21 April 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 12 March 2023, at around 8:12 PM, a residential fire incident transpired in Brgy. Banago, Bacolod City. According to the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) – Bacolod City, the fire was caused by faulty electrical wires. The fire was declared out at around 8:39 PM.
