



DSWD DROMIC Report on the Flashflood Incident in Brgy. Bual, Isulan, Sultan Kudarat

23 April 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 30 March 2023, a flashflood incident was experienced at Purok 3B and Purok 2 of Brgy. Bual, Isulan, Sultan Kudarat due to a damaged dike along the Mangilala creek caused by heavy rains brought by easterlies or localized thunderstorms.
