



DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. San Rafael, Rodriguez, Rizal

25 April 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 31 March 2023 at around 8:30 AM, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Wawa, Brgy. San Rafael, Rodriguez, Rizal between the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and members of the Communist Terrorist Group – New People's Army (CTG-NPA).

A total of **614 families** or **2,499 persons** were affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Rodriguez**, **Rizal** (see Table 1).

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **70 families** or **406 persons** sought temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Rodriguez**, **Rizal** (see Table 2).
