



# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Effects of Localized Thunderstorms in Brgy. Lumbangan, Mabinay, Negros Oriental

05 May 2024, 6PM

# I. Situation Overview

On 21 April 2023, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms due to Easterlies or Localized Thunderstorms may have caused possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms in Metro Manila and the rest of the country.

At 12:30 PM, severe thunderstorms due to localized thunderstorms brought hail, heavy rains and strong winds in Brgy. Lumbangan and on other parts of Mabinay, Negros Oriental.

A total of **four (4) families** or **32 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Lumbangan**, **Mabinay**, **Negros Oriental** (see Annex A).

### **Outside Evacuation Center**

There are **four (4) families** or **32 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **four (4) houses** were damaged; of which, **two (2)** are **totally damaged** and **two (2)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Lumbangan, Mabinay, Negros Oriental** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱4,064.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱2,464.00 from DSWD and ₱1,600.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
