





DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Mambaling, Cebu City

09 February 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 19 April 2023, at around 2:46PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Manga, Brgy. Mambaling, Cebu City. The fire was under control at around 2:43PM and was declared fire out at around 3:05PM.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VII together with the LGU of Cebu City, provided relief and financial assistance to support the immediate needs of affected families and individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **119 families** or **419 persons** are affected in **Sitio Manga, Brgy. Mambaling, Cebu City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There were **39 families** or **113 persons** took temporary shelter at the **Mambaling Elementary School** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There were **80 families** or **306 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

c. Total Displaced Population

There were 119 families or 419 persons displaced in Sitio Manga, Brgy. Mambaling, Cebu City (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **57 houses** were damaged; of which, **50** are **totally damaged** and **seven (7)** are **partially damaged** in **Sitio Manga, Brgy. Mambaling, Cebu City** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}\$5,974,072.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; composed of \$\mathbb{P}\$2,357,222.00 from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}\$3,616,850.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex F).
