

## DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. San Juan, Taytay, Rizal

02 May 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 08 April 2023 at 9:40 PM, a fire incident occurred at Rosario St., Brgy. San Juan, Taytay, Rizal. It was declared fire out at around 11:50 PM.
