

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Flash Flood Incident in Region XII

18 February 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 31 March 2023, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms caused by easterlies or localized thunderstorms may have caused flashfloods or landslides during severe thunderstorms in Metro Manila and the rest of the country.

From 31 March to 02 April 2023, low-lying municipalities in the Provinces of Cotabato and Sultan Kudarat experienced flashfloods caused by either easterlies or localized thunderstorms.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **1,683 families** or **7,956 persons** were affected in **seven (7) barangays** in **Region XII** (see Annex A).

III. Damaged Houses

A total of **63 houses** were damaged; of which, **five (5)** are **totally damaged** and **58** are **partially damaged** in **Region XII** (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **745,916.00** worth of assistance was provided by **Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD)** to the affected families (see Annex C).
