

## DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Flashflood Incident in Pikit, Cotabato

02 May 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 05 April 2023, four (4) low-lying barangays in Pikit, Cotabato experienced flashfloods due to sustained heavy rains caused by localized thunderstorms.
