I. Situation Overview

On 03 May 2023 at around 4PM, an armed conflict between the Philippine Army (PA) and the New People's Army (NPA) transpired in Brgy. Hilamonan, Kabankalan City and Brgy. Buenavista, Himamaylan City in Negros Occidental which resulted in the displacement of families and individuals in the area.

1. Standby Funds

- ₱28.48 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 33,629 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 15,001 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 18,628 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
