I. Situation Overview

1. Standby Funds

- ₱902.36 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱4.9 million available at DSWD FO NCR.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 60,415 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 22,887 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 37,528 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 1,200 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
- ₱210.78 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.
