

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 783, Sta Ana, Manila City as of 09 May 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 05 May 2023 at around 11:03 AM, a fire incident occurred at Tejeron St., cor Liwayway St., Brgy. 783, Sta Ana, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 12PM.
