I. Situation Overview

On 05 May 2023 at around 11:03 AM, a fire incident occurred at Tejeron St., cor Liwayway St., Brgy. 783, Sta Ana, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 12PM.

- 33,217 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 11,589 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 21,628 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 6,342 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
- ₱191.99 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.
