



# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Angad, Bangued, Abra

as of 06 May 2023, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 30 April 2023 at around 11:26 PM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Angad, Bangued, Abra. The fire was declared out at 1:45 AM on 01 May 2023. According to the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP), the cause of fire was due to unattended lit candle. *Source: DSWD Field Office (FO) CAR*
