### I. Situation Overview

On 17 May 2023 at around 1:20 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Bal-ason, Gingoog City, Misamis Oriental. The fire was declared out at around 5AM.

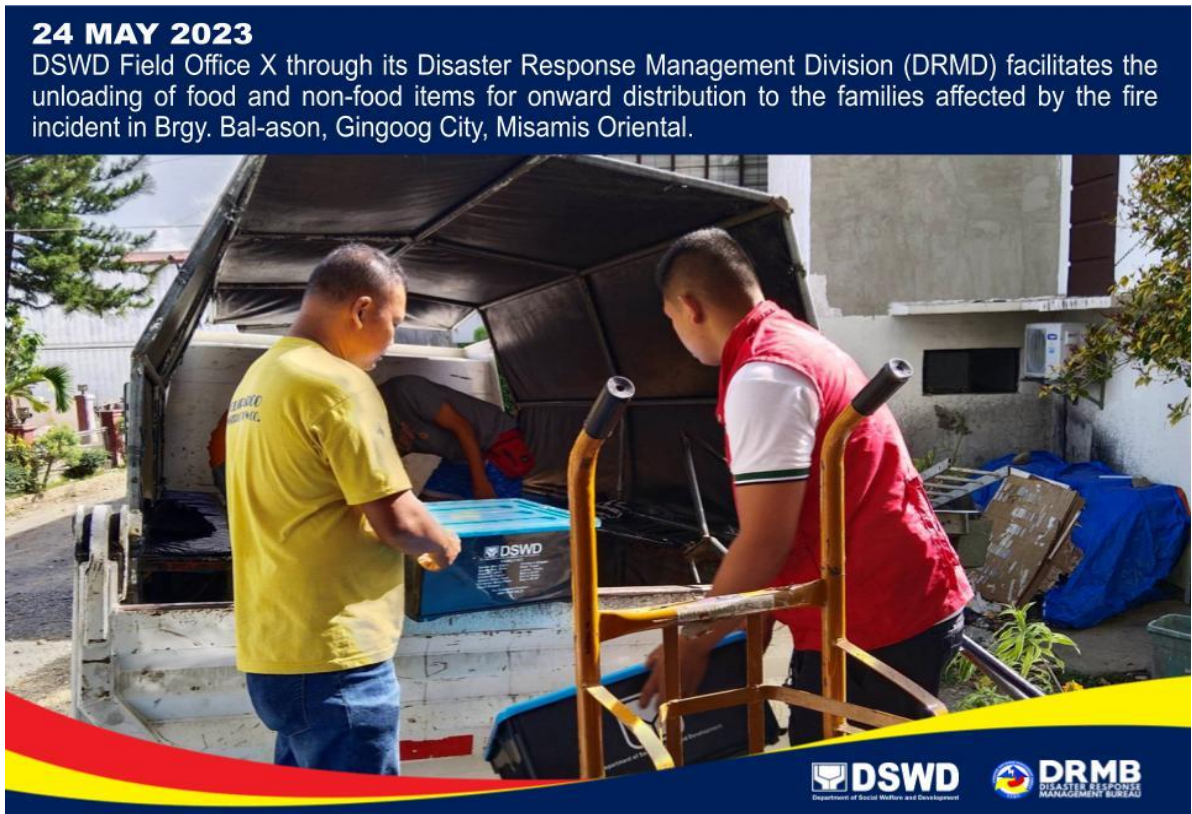
