1. Standby Funds

- ₱538.96 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5.5 million available at DSWD FO CALABARZON.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 110,667 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 101,525 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 9,142 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 41,429 FFPs available at DSWD FO CALABARZON.
- ₱265.85 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO CALABARZON warehouses.
