I. Situation Overview

On 19 May 2023 at around 1:22 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 2C, Brgy. Casinglot, Tagoloan, Misamis Oriental. The fire was declared fire out at 2:05 PM. Source: DSWD Field Office (FO) X

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of six (6) families or 37 persons are affected in Purok 2C, Brgy. Casinglot, Tagoloan, Misamis Oriental (see Table 1).

1. Standby Funds

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 53,631 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 44,489 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 9,142 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 42,131 FFPs available at DSWD FO X.

19 May 2023	 The Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO) of the LGU of Tagoloan, Misamis Oriental and the Barangay LGU of Casinglot provided FNIs to the affected families. The Barangay LGU of Casinglot set up a community kitchen for the affected families.

c. Camp Coordination and Camp Management (CCCM)

22 May 2023	• DSWD FO X, through its Disaster Response Management Division (DRMD), provided FNIs such as FFPs, family kits, hygiene kits, kitchen kits, and sleeping kits to the affected families.
19 May 2023	• The MSWDO of the LGU of Tagoloan, Misamis Oriental conducted interviews and validation of the affected families.

d. Other Activities
