On 03 May 2023 at around 7PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Montilla, Moises Padilla, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 7:55 PM.

1. Standby Funds

- ₱28.48 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO VI.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 40,217 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 18,589 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 21,628 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 79,779 FFPs available at DSWD FO VI.
- ₱190.9 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VI warehouses.
